Current Operating Restrictions EFFECTIVE 3/22/2021	Occupancy is 50% of fire marshal capacity or 400 people (whichever is fewer) if six feet of physical distance can be maintained. There is an exception of one to one service in an enclosed room.	Indoor capacity is capped at 50%, up to 125 people, whichever is fewer (excluding staff). Mask removal only allowed for actual taking of the photo. Outdoor group portraits are allowed up to 125 people maximum and mask removal only allowed during actual taking of the photo.	For museums less than 100,00 square feet, the maximum number of individuals is 400 or 50% of capacity, whichever is less. For museums larger than 100,000 square feet, the maximum number of individuals is 600 or 50% of capacity, whichever is less.	Indoor and outdoor services allowed.
